**LEAVES...** The Village crew has begun to pick up loose leaves from the curbside and will continue to do so until Friday, November 17th weather permitting. **The last day to place your loose leaves at the curb is Thursday November 16th**, after that all leaves will have to be bagged for pick up. **Please remember to rake them near the curb, still on the grass, not in the road** where they can block the flow of water drainage.

**... PARKING** Our snow local law goes into affect on November 1<sup>st</sup> until April 1<sup>st</sup> stating that **NO PARKING** is permitted on all village streets or over sidewalks between the hours of 2:00AM and 6:00AM. The reason for this is to allow the snowplow & sidewalk plow easy snow removal and safety for our drivers. Please note that the Village is not responsible for any damaged mailboxes or posts.

### **... PORTABLE BASKETBALL HOOPS**

It is mandatory that any basketball equipment be removed from the village right of way. This is a dangerous situation, not only children playing in the road, but trucks hitting it. As the snow season approaches, a snowplow's force can make it a projectile. Please remove it immediately.
