**LEAVES...** The Village crew has begun to pick up loose leaves from the curbside and will continue to do so until Friday, November 16<sup>th</sup>, weather permitting. **The last day to place your loose leaves at the curb is Thursday November 15th**, after that all leaves will have to be bagged for pick up. Please remember to rake them near the curb, still on the grass, not in the road where they can block the flow of water drainage.

... **PARKING** The following will be **strictly enforced:** Our snow local law goes into effect on November 1<sup>st</sup> until April 1<sup>st</sup> stating that **NO PARKING** is permitted on all village streets between the hours of 2:00AM and 6:00AM. At no time is parking permitted over village sidewalks. This allows the snowplow & sidewalk plow easier snow removal. Please note that the Village is not responsible for any damaged mailboxes or posts.
