LEAVES... The Village crew has begun to pick up loose leaves from the curbside and will continue to do so until Friday, November 20th, weather permitting. **The last day to place your loose leaves at the curb is Thursday November 19th**, after that all leaves will have to be bagged for pick up. Please remember to rake them near the curb, still on the grass, not in the road where they can block the flow of water drainage. **THERE WILL BE NO BRUSH OR BAGGED LEAF PICK UP AFTER DECEMBER 1ST UNTIL RESUMING SCHEDULE ON APRIL 1ST.**

PARKING: The following will be **strictly enforced:** Our snow local law goes into effect on November 1st until April 1st stating that **NO PARKING** is permitted on all village streets between the hours of 2:00AM and 6:00AM.
