**LEAVES...** The Village crew has begun to pick up loose leaves from the curbside and will continue to do so until Thursday, November 15th, weather permitting. **The last day to place your loose leaves at the curb is Wednesday November 14th**, after that all leaves will have to be bagged for pick up. Please remember to rake them near the curb, not in the road where they can block the flow of water drainage. **THERE WILL BE NO BRUSH PICK UP AFTER NOV. 15<sup>TH</sup> NO BAGGED LEAF PICK UP AFTER NOV. 30<sup>TH</sup> UNTIL RESUMING ON APRIL 1<sup>ST</sup> 2013.** We will pick up Christmas trees from Dec. 26<sup>th</sup> to Jan. 18<sup>th</sup>.

**PARKING:** The following will be **strictly enforced:** Our local law on snow removal goes into effect **on November 1<sup>st</sup> until April 1<sup>st</sup> stating that NO PARKING is permitted on all village streets between the hours of 2:00AM and 6:00AM.** At no time is parking permitted over village sidewalks. Please note that the Village is not responsible for any damaged mailboxes or posts.
