SCOUTING FOR FOOD

This bill reflects the following rate increase:

Water(W): the minimum amount is now \$26.00 for the first 5,000 of water used; the overage is remaining the same at \$4.50 each 1,000 gallons of water over 5,000 gallons. The water meter rent is changing from \$2.00 per quarter to \$4.00 per quarter.

Sewer(S): There are no changes in sewer charges at this time. A minimum bill W & S bill will be \$100.00 every three months.



LEAVES... The last day to place your loose leaves at the curb is Thursday November 17th, (weather permitting) after that all leaves will have to be bagged for pick up. Please remember to rake them near the curb, not in the road where they can block the flow of water drainage. **THERE WILL BE NO BRUSH PICK UP AFTER NOV. 18th. NO BAGGED LEAF PICK UP AFTER NOV. 25TH UNTIL RESUMING IN APRIL 2017.** We will pick up Christmas trees from Dec. 26th to Jan. 22nd.

ALL OBSTACLES (SHRUBS, LANDSCAPING TIMBER, ORNAMENTAL GADGETS) ALONG THE SIDEWALKS MUST BE PLACED OR TRIMMED 10 INCHES TO 1 FOOT FROM THE EDGE SO THE SIDEWALK PLOW HAS CLEARANCE. HEDGES AND SHRUBS WILL BE REMOVED BY THE DPW IF NOT TRIMMED BACK.

PARKING: Our local law on snow removal goes into effect on **November 1st until April 1st stating that NO PARKING is permitted on all village streets between the hours of 2:00AM and 6:00AM.** At no time is parking permitted over village sidewalks.
