**Spring Clean up** will be on Monday May 10<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday May 11<sup>th</sup>. **We are asking you to make three separate piles. This is very important.** You risk not having your things picked up and being billed by private contractor if not taken care of.

▶ **White goods and scrap metal.** Only stoves, water heaters or other metal objects that contain no freon. We will not pick up propane tanks, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, or freon containing items.\*

▶ **Garden & yard waste.** All garden and yard waste must be bagged and the bags contain only garden and yard waste (grass clippings, small twigs, leaves etc.). Please remember that these bags must be lifted up and over the side of the truck. If you cannot lift them up 5 feet, neither can our village crew. Please make the bags lighter and use biodegradable bags if possible. No loose leaves or debris should be in the street gutters to block the flow of water to the storm drains.

▶ **Large household waste.** This includes furniture, carpets, bedsprings, mattresses, TV's, etc.

**We cannot and will not pick up:** tires, construction and demolition materials, recyclables or any hazardous waste such as paint, gas cans or gas grill propane tanks. No refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers or other refrigerants.\*

The Town of Manchester (Corner of Route 96 & County Road 7) will take old tires for a charge of \$2.00 per tire. The hours to bring them are Monday & Wednesday 4-7pm and Saturday 9am-4pm. Tire coupons can be purchased at the Town office. \*Refrigerants will be accepted until the end of July. Telephone: 289-3010

**The schedule for Spring pick up is as follows:**

**MONDAY, MAY 10<sup>TH</sup>:** Main Street, Merrick Avenue, Lehigh Avenue, Gilligan Drive, Bennett Avenue, Smith Place, Smith Terrace, Pratt Road, Howard Street, Wilson Street, Moses Road, Vanderwall Drive, Center Street, Clifton Street (West of Outlet), State Street.

**TUESDAY, MAY 11<sup>TH</sup>:** North Avenue, South Avenue, Clifton Street (East of Outlet), Newton Street, Edgemere Drive.

This spring pick up is a service for **Village residents only**. Non-village residents using this service will be subject to prosecution.

## FROM THE MAYOR – BRUCE MILES

When I was campaigning, there were a lot of comments on what was needed to improve our village. I have started to correct some of these issues but I find that a lot of our residents don't know what the Village Codes are. I felt that I should inform you before our Code Enforcement Officer sends you a letter. We will be enforcing all Village and Traffic Codes. If you are in doubt, call the village office or our Code Enforcement Officer, Steve DeHond at 289-3010 Ext. 107. Listed below are some specific codes I have had questions about:

### Code # 87.12

No person shall ride, drive, operate or park any motor driven vehicle, including snowmobiles and minibikes upon any public sidewalk or path intended for use by pedestrians within the Village of Manchester.

### Code # 61.4

Nuisance, hazards and litter – includes, but shall not be limited to, abandoned automobiles or any part thereof unless such party has a license to store the same; any waste metal or material, garbage, refuse, rubbish, old refrigerators, stove or like products; used bottles or cans, glass, wood, lumber or vegetable matter of any kind or any other matter which shall be flammable or capable of fermentation, evaporation or decay; abandoned buildings or construction materials or supplies; discarded paper or material of junk substances; and tree stumps or matter attractive to vermin, likely to breed disease, cause fire or be prejudicial to good health.

### Code # 27.3

It shall be unlawful for any owner of or any person harboring any dog in the Village of Manchester to permit or allow such dog to: Cause damage or destruction to property or commit a nuisance (dog poo) upon the premises of a person other than the owner or a person harboring such dog.

### Code # 100-29

It is illegal to park, or sell a vehicle, boat, snowmobile, etc. in front of your residence. They may be sold in your side yard not beyond the front of your house. It is also illegal to park between the curb and sidewalk.

If we are to improve the looks of the Village **WE MUST START NOW!!!** Clean Up is coming. Let's get rid of the junk. Call if you need information on getting rid of junk cars. I want to clean our village and I need your help.
