The snow has finally arrived and the village crew has been working diligently keeping ahead of the snow removal. We have received many compliments for a job well done. They appreciate everyone's effort to keep cars off the street and sidewalks and not parking in the road overnight. Please remember that cars must be kept off the streets from 2:00am to 6:00am (from November 1st to April 1st) to allow efficiency in snowplowing. This year it has been noticed that garbage receptacles have been placed in the sidewalk path. The operator of the sidewalk plow has to get out and move them. Please place them out of the way of the sidewalk plow.

When removing snow from driveways & sidewalks, please check if the sidewalk has any ridges of excess snow. When this snow freezes it makes it difficult for pedestrians to get around it. There have been an increased number of people putting snow in the road. This makes for dangerous driving conditions. Village Law **prohibits snowplowing or shoveling snow from your property into the public streets. Legal action will be taken against those breaking this law.**

 Please note that, by law, the Village is not responsible for replacing broken or damaged mailboxes. Unfortunately, broken mailboxes do happen. It is usually the weight of ice and snow that breaks them. We also have a request from the post office to aid their mail delivery by removing the snow around a good portion of your mailbox allowing easier access. Thereby removing the snow helps prevent the mailbox from breaking and it also helps the mail carrier easier access to your mailbox.
