FROM THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

ROUTE 21 and SOUTH AVENUE IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

The Route 21 and the South Avenue Improvement Projects are scheduled to begin in April 2007. The detour around the railroad bridge will be the South Main Street extension east and parallel of the Route 21 site. **FROM POLICE CHIEF WILLIAM DEAN: THE SPEED LIMIT THROUGH THIS DETOUR AREA WILL BE 20MPH AND WILL BE STRICTLY ADHERED TO. ALL FINES ARE DOUBLED IN A CONSTRUCTION AREA.** There will be no detour at the South Avenue site. The projects will be worked on simultaneously.
