The enclosed February 1st water & sewer statement is covering the last quarter of the year 2009. It is due by February 20th without penalty. All arrears and payments after Feb. 20th must be made by April 15th 2010, after which time we forward unpaid water & sewer to Ontario County to be levied upon property taxes. A reminder letter will be sent.



With all the snow we have had this winter, please remember that cars must be kept off the streets from 2:00am to 6:00am (from November 1st to April 1st) to allow efficiency in snowplowing. You may be ticketed or have the car towed away.

When removing snow from driveways & sidewalks, please check if the sidewalk has any excess snow. When this snow freezes it makes it difficult for pedestrians to get around it. Also, it is prohibited to plow or shovel snow from your property in the public streets.

Please note that, by law, the Village is not responsible for replacing broken or damaged mailboxes. Unfortunately, broken mailboxes do happen. It is usually the weight of ice and snow that breaks them.

March 9th is the last day for the village clerk to receive applications for absentee ballots to be mailed to a qualified voter.
